Agenda Item No. 5: Port Director's Report.

Charles R. Hausmann, Port Director, reported the following:

- A. Harbor Traffic Statistics for the month of June:
 - That a total of 130 vessels had arrived at the public port facilities during the month of June; 27 deep draft arrivals and 103 inland barges and a total of 217 invoices were issued. Further, that 19 deep draft vessels were already on schedule for July arrival.
 - Total revenue tons for the month of June were 469,569.1 short tons. Total revenue tons for FY2018 were 4,958,373.2 short tons. We finished the year 33% ahead of FY2017.
- B. NGL loaded out 23 crude oil barges totaling 75,906.8 short tons.
- C. Seadrift Coke lightered 10 barges of needle coke totaling 9,504.4 short tons to 2 ships for export.
